Also, a reminder that our school Breakfast Club and Library are not available until 8:30am. Outside supervision is only offered at the front of the school from 8:40am by a rotating staff member; there is no supervision at the side of the school (primary undercover).

LAX KXEEN LOST AND FOUND

Lax Kxeen's Lost and Found bin has grown. If your child is missing something, please come to the school to have a look; their items may be in the Lost & Found bin or on the coat rack at the front of the school.

CELL PHONES/ PERSONAL ITEMS

Please remind your child(ren) to keep cell phones and personal items at home. Students that bring personal items to school are encouraged to keep them in their backpacks so that they are safe and don't go missing. We are discouraging students from bringing personal effects like toys and trinkets as they may get misplaced.

PARKING LOT

For the safety of our students please do not stop and park within the yellow zone at the front of the school. This is a spot to allow your child(ren) to get out of the vehicle (drop-off zone), but not a spot for an extended park and wait. Vehicles parked here cause a blockade that backs up traffic and is potentially hazardous to other cars and students trying to emerge out of a vehicle. People waiting will be asked by staff to move their vehicle. It is strongly encouraged that students get dropped off at the entrance area and walk in. Continued difficulties with navigating the parking lot safely, may result in gate closure. We want to ensure that your child(ren) are safe while at school. ©
